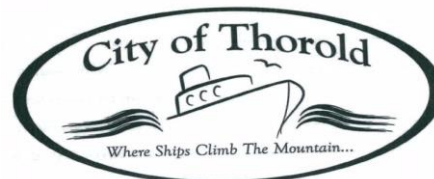

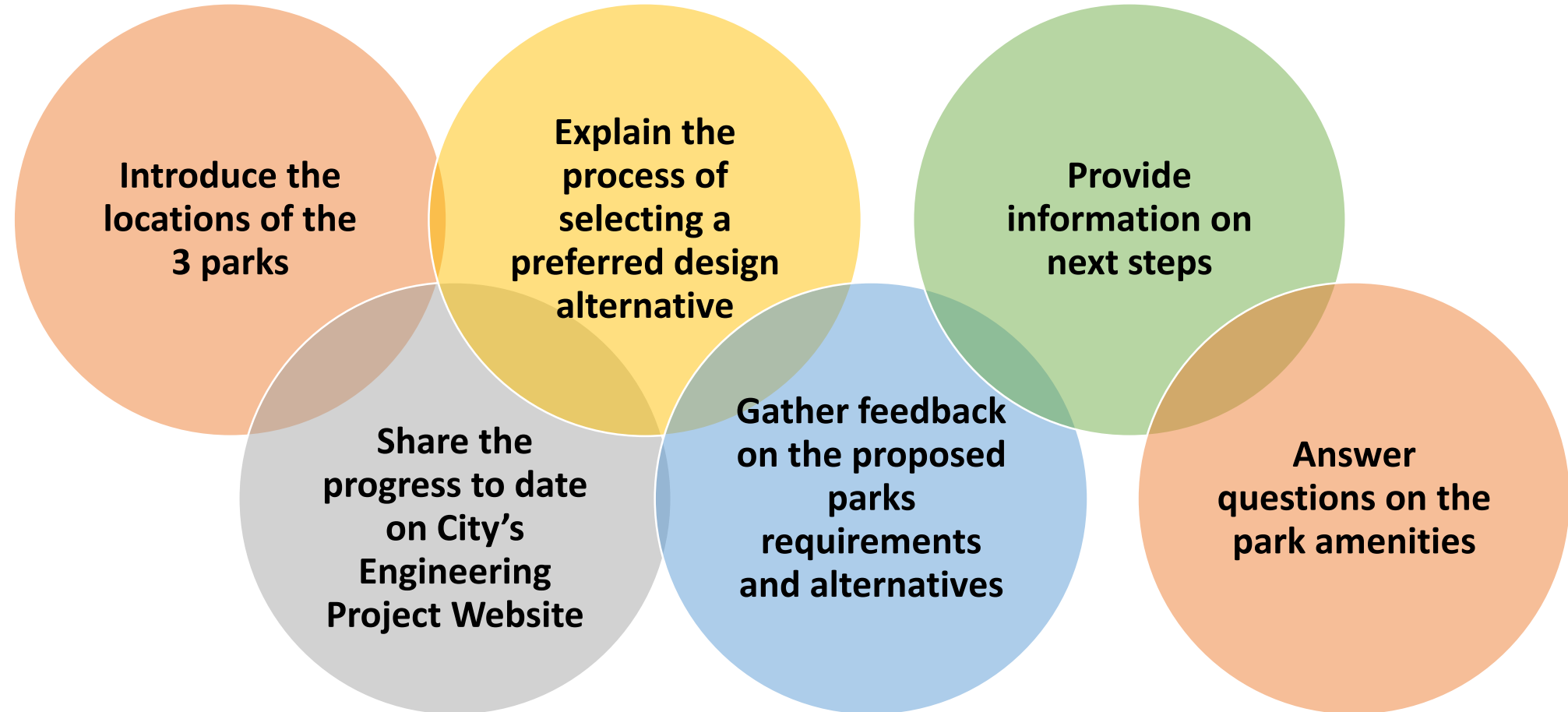

PURPOSE OF THE PIC



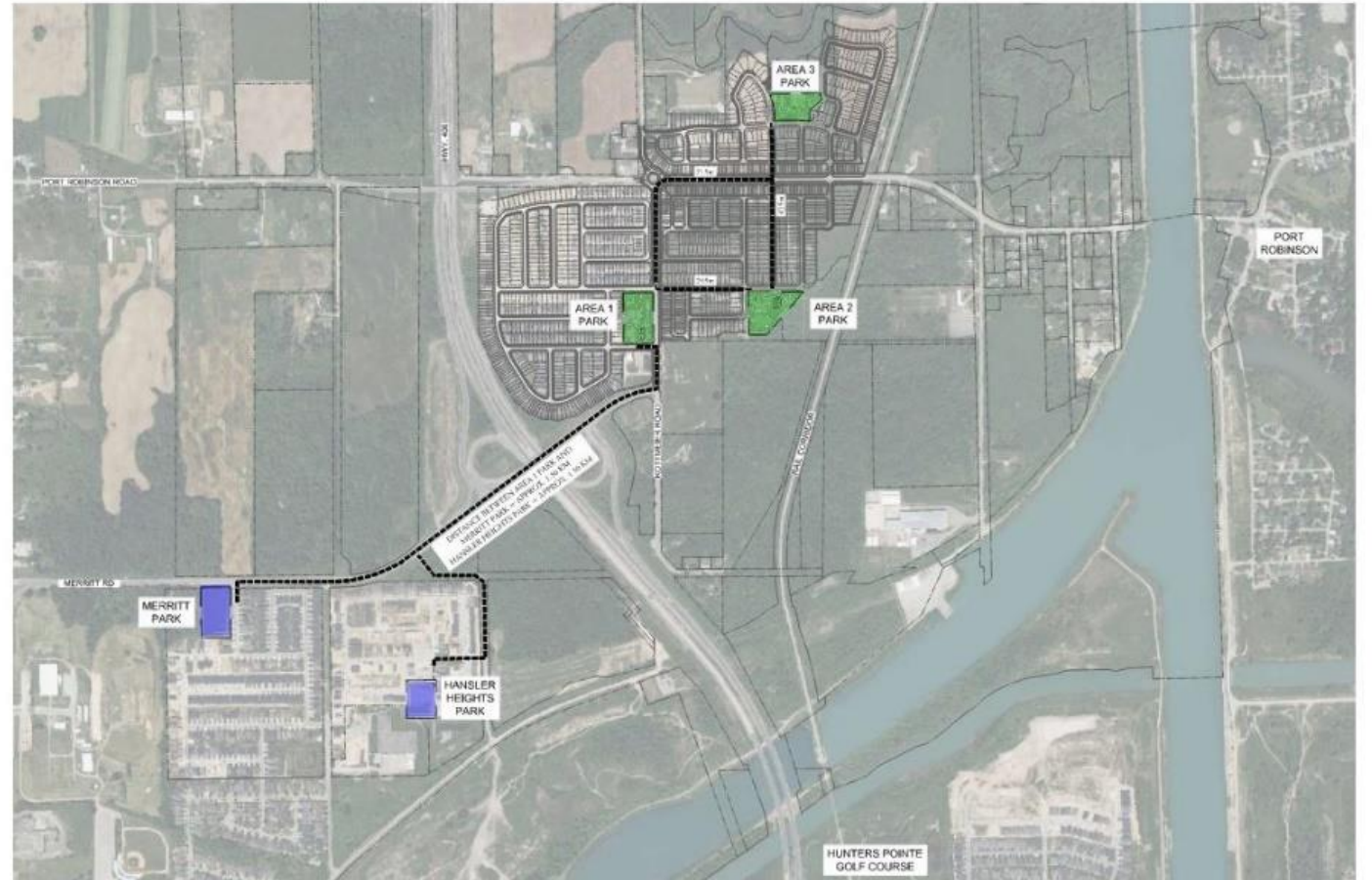
Overview

To undertake the design of three (3) new parks in Port Robinson West areas of Kottmeier Road and Port Robinson Road (herein referred to as Area 1, 2 & 3 Parks).

Proposed project as is the result of the Thorold's Parks and Recreation Master Plan **complete in 2020**

The proposed parks are intended to provide the minimum park amenities to residents on the east and west sides of Kottmeier Road in Port Robinson West, and also for residents living on the north areas of Port Robinson Road.

PROBLEM STATEMENT

The City of Thorold completed the Parks, Trails and Recreation Master Plan in October 2020. The Park Master Plan identified the need to bridge the gaps in parks supply and the need to provide municipal parks that is sufficient to serve the existing population within a reasonable travelling distance for most residents in the Port Robinson West neighborhoods.

The City of Thorold has initiated to undertake a study through this Public Information Centre Meeting to solicit input from residents for the proposed parks design in Port Robinson West neighborhoods.

Proposed Parks Amenities

The goal is to provide park amenities that will support both current and future residential development in the Port Robinson West areas of the City. The proposed parks may include but are not limited to the following:






- Playground (junior and senior structure)
- Multi-purpose grass field
- Multi-purpose sports court (i.e. Basketball and ball hockey)
- Splash pad
- Walkways
- Benches
- Picnic tables
- Shade structure and community gathering space
- Tree planting
- Ornamental planting
- Parking lot
- Adult fitness equipment
- Lighting
- Washrooms

Evaluation Factor	Overview
General	Ability to support the current and future residential development/growths in Port Robinson West neighborhoods.
Natural	Considerations for the protection of natural, ecological and physical environment.
Social / Cultural	Considerations to promote social programs/activities for park users, individuals, groups, communities and cultural resources.
Technical	Technical, engineering and operational considerations and other constraints.
Economic	Considerations related to the cost to design, construct, operate and maintain.

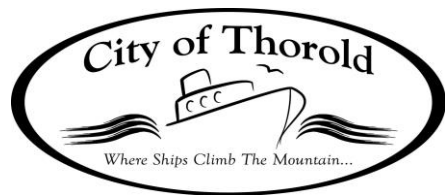
