## Council Highlights

- Mayor Ugolini provided remarks related to COVID-19, HOPA Ports and Town & Gown Committee. He also announced a successful grant application and on behalf of OPG informed residents that skating on Lake Gibson and Marlatt's Pond is prohibited due to safety reasons.
- Regional Councillor Whalen was in attendance and provided highlights of the 2021 Regional budget.
- Tim Whalen, Chair of Runway of Recognition Committee advised that due to COVID-19 the event planned for March 2020 will be held when able to do so safely and any tickets purchased will be honoured for the new date. He also advised that the White Family Foundation Scholarship is open for applications.
- Representatives from One Thorold – Housing Group were in attendance to raise awareness of housing challenges in the community.
- Council approved a motion to consider a proposal to establish a walking and cycling trail on Decew Road during the 2021 budget deliberations.
- Council approved the removal of ice in the Doherty Arena for the balance of the 2020-2021 winter season.
- Council appointed a new member to the Active Transportation Advisory Committee.
- Council established a Road Safety Committee and recruitment for four (4) at-large members will commence.
- A Site Alteration By-law to Regulate the Removal, Placing or Dumping of Fill was adopted by Council.
- Notice was given that at the February 16, 2021 meeting, Council intends to consider correspondence received from the Niagara Regional Police Services Board about Medical Cannabis Grow Operations and Public Safety Concerns and lowering of the flag at City Hall to mark the one year anniversary of COVID-19.
