## Council Highlights

- Mayor Ugolini provided remarks related to COVID-19 vaccine distribution, thanked Community Groups who continue to meet virtually to advance important initiatives in the municipality. He reminded residents to refrain from parking on the streets during snow events. Mayor Ugolini commended Council and Staff for their efforts put forward during 2021 budget deliberations achieving a 1.8% rate increase.
- Council supported the position of the Niagara Regional Police Services Board pertaining to Medical Cannabis Grow Operations - Public Safety Concerns.
- Council supported a motion to lower the flag at City Hall from March 12 to 14, 2021 in recognition and acknowledgement of the one year anniversary of COVID-19.
- Council entered into a Fee for Service Agreement with the Thorold Community Activities Group (TCAG) for the provision of recreation and leisure programming services for the community.
