Council Meeting – October 5, 2021

- Council received an update [presentation](#) from Niagara Region on the 1-5 Year Transportation Capital Budget Outlook.
- Staff have been asked to review the Disposal of Real Property Policy and provide recommendations on changes.
- The Artisan Ridge – Phase 2 pre-servicing agreement was approved.
- The City of Thorold is now recruiting for committee positions on Thorold Tourism, Parks, Trails and Recreation, and Road Safety Committees. We encourage those interested to submit an [application](#) to the Office of the City Clerk!
- Project updates were provided for Sullivan Avenue/Clairmont Street/Front Street South, Broderick Avenue Road Construction, Municipal Operations Centre and St. David's Road.
- Council approved the Draft Plan of Vacant Land Condominium for Peach Street.
- 52 Front Street will be receiving a Façade Improvement Grant in for \$7,500 under the Façade Improvement Grant Program.
