Funding Received!

- Mayor Ugulini announced that the City will receive up to \$230,414 in Phase 3 COVID-19 Safe Restart Agreement funding from the Provincial Ministry of Transportation and \$421,958 in 2021 COVID-19 Recovery Funding from the Provincial Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing in order to support our COVID-19 operating costs and pressures.
- The City is eligible to receive up to \$9,200 as part of the Provincial Fire Safety Grant to assist in addressing challenges associated with training and virtual inspections to the COVID-19 pandemic.

COVID-19 Pandemic

- Mayor Ugulini updated that COVID-19 vaccinations began on March 22, 2021 for residents 75 years plus and that appointments can be booked by phone or through the Province's online booking portal.

Planning and Development

- The Draft Plan of Subdivision for Upper's Grove, Rolling Meadows and Empire Legacy South and North Lands were approved.
- A policy was approved to expedite the Building Permit application process to construct houses identical to others that have been previously constructed within the municipality.

Finance

- The Water and Urban Service Area (Sanitary Sewers and Sidewalks Budget) was approved. The water quarterly metered rate structure will remain at the 2020 rates.

Public Works and Community Services

- Empire Homes has committed to increasing the level of maintenance on Port Robinson Road during the construction of the development. A by-law will be brought to a future meeting for consideration. It will propose to prohibit the obstruction, encumbering or fouling of municipal roadways.

Committees

- The Age Friendly Committee will be producing a 2022/2023 wall calendar to showcase active living in Thorold featuring multi-generational and diverse participants at Thorold locations and landmarks.
