- Mayor Ugulini shared that residents are volunteering to clean up garbage around the community. He thanked everyone for their spirit of giving back to the community.
- Greater Niagara Chamber of Commerce Business Achievement Awards to Thorold businesses: Norgen Biotek - Innovative Leaders, My Local Connection - Excellence in Agribusiness, Farming & Rural Achievement, and The Niagara Industrial Association Community Leadership Award.
- Thorold resident Tyler Angle signed a 3-year contract with the NHL's Columbus Blue Jackets.
- Councillors Sentance and Neale volunteered for the March 2021 Meals on Wheels campaign to deliver meals to Thorold adults living with disabilities and seniors.

COVID-19 Pandemic

- Mayor Ugulini updated that Regional Council continues to meet every two weeks, Friday, 2:00 p.m. to receive COVID-19 pandemic and vaccine updates from Public Health. The meetings are live streamed on the Niagara Region website.
- Mayor Ugulini asked that everyone follow Public Health Safety Measures and support one another, frontline workers, those less fortunate or living alone and our local businesses.

Planning and Development

- A Public Meeting was held to present an application for a zoning by-law amendment for Confederation Heights Phase 8. A report from Planning staff will be presented to Council at a future meeting.
- Council approved a by-law amendment to allow for outdoor commercial patios for permitted uses.

Economic Development/Tourism

- Council approved an agreement with Venture Niagara to continue providing tourism services to the City.

Public Works and Community Services

- The St. David's Road, Water and Storm Reconstruction was awarded and a cost-sharing agreement for the work was entered into with the City of St. Catharines.
- Council approved the Operational Plan for the City's Water Distribution System. The 2020 Water Quality Reports will be posted to the website.
