- John Murray, General Manager, PDS Citywide provided a presentation on the city's Asset Management Plan.
- Matt Robinson, Director of GO Implementation Office, presented on Niagara Transit Governance, Phase 1 Feedback.
- Routine finance related reports were received by Council.
