

The Corporation of the City of Thorold

By-law No. 2021-91

Being a by-law to replace Schedule A to By-Law 119-2017, being a By-Law to Regulate Firearms in the City of Thorold

Whereas section 119 of the Municipal Act, 2001 authorizes municipalities to enact By-laws, for the purpose of public safety, to prohibit or regulate the discharge of firearms; and

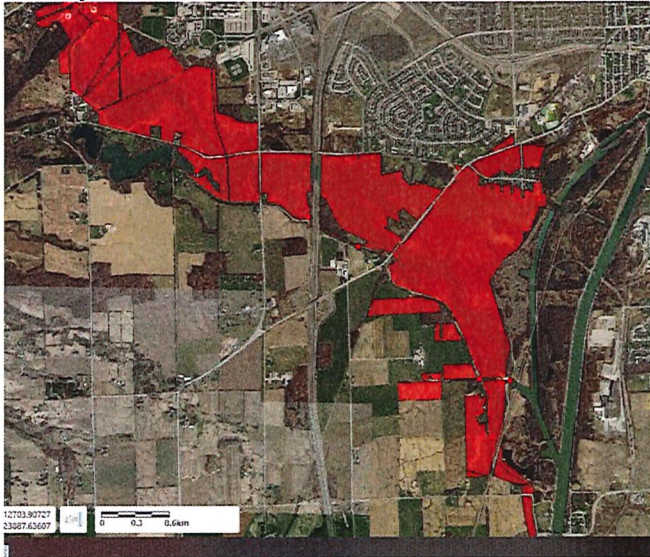
Whereas Council deems it advisable to update Schedule A to By-Law 119-2017 to regulate the discharge of firearms within the City of Thorold.

Now therefore be it resolved that the Council of The Corporation of the City of Thorold hereby enacts as follows:


1. THAT Council include the Ontario Power Generation Lands at Lakes Gibson and Moodie and the flood lands around the basins, as part of the "Prohibited Area doe the Use of Firearms and Bows," attached as Schedule A; and

2. THAT a new clause be included as follows:

4.2 (g) No person shall discharge any firearm or hunt on lands located on Ontario Power Generation lands, including, but not limited to the following PIN's: 46414-0310; 46414-0308; 64043-0907; 64042-0022; 64042-0098; 64042-0049; 64055-0501; 64055-0526; 64055-0505; 64059-0066; 64059-0386; 64055-0244; and 64055-0245, as illustrated in the sketch below, and known locally as Lake Moodie and Lake Gibson and surrounding flood basins:



Read a first, second and third time and finally passed by Council this 7th day of September, 2021.
