The Project Manager position is responsible to provide leadership and management of the planning, design, implementation and construction of linear municipal infrastructure and support the municipalities Drinking Water Quality Management System.

- Four (4) years of progressively responsible experience in diverse public works or engineering consulting environment.
- Extensive experience with all aspects of engineering design, contract administration and construction. Registered as P. Eng. with Professional Engineers Ontario/registration as C.E.T. with Ontario Association of Certified Engineering Technicians and Technologists.
- Thorough knowledge and experience with AutoCAD, and ArcGIS
- Thorough knowledge and experience of engineering design, contract administration and construction management of municipal infrastructure projects.
- Excellent interpersonal, project/time management, analytical, communication, presentation, problem-solving, facilitation, negotiations, and supervisory skills.
