The City of Thorold Public Works Department has made the necessary preparations to help all residents travel safely during the approaching winter conditions. In order to help us meet your expectations, we are asking for your cooperation to temporarily park all vehicles off the roadways during winter storm events.

The City of Thorold Traffic and Parking By-law does allow for vehicles to be temporarily relocated onto driveway aprons to accommodate snow clearing on the streets.

This notice is a friendly reminder that the City of Thorold's Parking and Traffic By-law No. 150-2012 prohibits on-street parking for longer than 12 hours at any one time and parking that interferes with winter maintenance operations. In order to maintain safe roadways in our community it is necessary to enforce this by-law to the fullest extent necessary to achieve compliance.
