ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE TWO AWARDS

To be eligible for a **2026 Thorold Senior of the Year Award**, the senior must meet these criteria:

- Be 60 years or older
- Has contributed to the enrichment of the social, cultural or civic life of the community
- Has made this commitment without thought of personal or financial gain
- Is not a previous recipient of the award
- A resident of the City of Thorold



To be eligible for a **2026 Thorold Centre 50+ Senior of the Year**, the senior must meet these criteria:

- Be 50 years or older
- Has contributed to the enrichment of the social and cultural life at the Thorold Centre 50+ by volunteering and through other positive endeavours
- Has made this commitment without thought of personal or financial gain
- Is not a previous recipient of the award
- Does not have to be a resident of the City of Thorold but must have been a member of the Thorold Centre 50+

Additional Nomination Eligibility Criteria for both Awards:

- All information must be verifiable
- Submissions must include:
 - Reason for the nomination? This includes background information
 - Volunteer information
 - Any other special work or service
 - The positive impact this volunteering has had on the City of Thorold community and/or at the Thorold Centre 50+
 - Who has benefited from these efforts?

You cannot nominate for both Awards:

- Yourself
- Someone who has passed away
- Someone who currently holds political office
- An individual cannot be nominated for an achievement related to a current or past political elected position
